Registration is open now for the ISL Education Lending Scholarship. This new opportunity expands and replaces two previous programs, the Save Now, Save Later Parent Giveaway and the Iowa Financial Know-How Challenge: Senior Scholarship.

The new ISL Education Lending Scholarship is an opportunity for all high school students, not just seniors, to learn about planning and paying for college. In addition, their parents or guardians and current college students may enter. Winners receive deposits into College Savings Iowa accounts so they can choose when and how to use the awards.

Encourage ninth- to 12th-grade students and their parents to enter for a chance to earn one of 45 \$1,000 deposits into a College Savings Iowa 529 account.

### **About the Scholarship**

The scholarship program is open to Iowa residents who are either:

- Iowa high school students.
- Undergraduate college students.
- Parents, guardians or others who hold a College Savings Iowa account benefiting an Iowa high school or undergraduate college student.

Online registration is simple. Your students should:

1. Visit [www.IowaStudentLoan.org/Enter](http://www.IowaStudentLoan.org/Enter) to register between September 1 and November 30, 2023.
2. Provide basic contact information for themselves and their parents or guardians.

After registering, students may continue to read three quick college planning and financing tips and answer a multiple choice question on each.

For the remainder of the scholarship period, registered students receive emailed information on college planning and financing.

Forty-five winners will be drawn from eligible high school, college and parent entries in December. Each winner will receive a \$1,000 deposit into a College Savings Iowa account.

### **Additional Chances to Win**

Each student may enter themselves only once per program period, but they have additional opportunities to win an award:

- A parent or guardian, or another adult who holds College Savings Iowa account naming the student as a beneficiary, may enter on their student's behalf once per program period.
- Students may register again for the spring program beginning in January 2024.
