- Maintains a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Has a clean driving record (no accidents or violations since he/she began driving)
- Plans to attend an accredited post-secondary educational institution in the fall of 2024 as a fulltime student
- Is not a dependent of any Grinnell Mutual employee or company officer

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The student or the student's parent or guardian must be a Grinnell Mutual customer when the scholarship is awarded. If the auto policy is canceled prior to this time for any reason, the scholarship is void and another recipient may be chosen.

All student applicants agree to the use of their name and photo in public announcements or scholarship advertising by Grinnell Mutual and its affiliated agents.

AWARD PRESENTATION

All scholarship recipients are randomly selected from qualified applicants. The selection decision will be final.
